



## Black Hills Grand Tour

- ① This 190 mile motorcycle ride starts off in historic Deadwood, SD. A town known for its gambling and gold mining history. Leaving Deadwood take Highway 85 South past Rochford, SD. Once you come to Highway 385 take it south towards Hill City, SD. In Hill City you can shop or get a bite to eat if you're hungry.
- ② Continue on Highway 385 South. Stop at Crazy Horse on your way to Custer, SD. Crazy Horse is a **must see attraction** for any visitor to the Black Hills.
- ③ Custer is the oldest town in the Black Hills and we go through it on our way to New Castle, WY will pass through the National Forest on your way to panoramic views of the open prairies of Wyoming.
- Trom New Castle take off to Cheyenne Crossing. The terrain reverts to hills, curves and beautiful scenery, following Spearfish Creek to Cheyenne Crossing.
- ⑤ Cheyenne Crossing is a good place to stop to eat and rest for before riding through to Spearfish Canyon.
- © Take Hwy 14A which cuts through Spearfish Canyon for some of the best riding in the hills, which includes a picturesque Bridal Veil Falls.

You'll end the ride winding your way along the canyons to I-90 in Spearfish, SD
